1. 10+2 or equivalent with Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry with a PCM aggregate of not less than ^{55%}₆₀.
OR

With Physics as individual subject in one of the year, B.Sc. in Physics, Mathematics, Chemistry or Electronics with an average of not less than 55% of marks in the final year.

OR

B.E./B.Tech. Degree

Should have passed in the English language as a subject, at either 10th or 12th standard or in the Degree/Diploma course, conducted by the Board or any University with not less than 50% marks.

Age Limit

2. Not more than 25 years on date of commencement of the training course.
The age limit is relaxable by 2 years in case of girl candidates.

Physical Standards

3. Medically fit as per the standards set by M. S. Medical Examination Rules, 2000.
Eyesight 6/6 in each eye without visual aids and no color blindness. Candidates have to undergo a full eyesight test conducted by the Mercantile Marine Department before being finally selected for the course.

After the training, external examinations is conducted by Board of Examination of Seafarers Trust under D.G Shipping (Govt of India). Students who successfully pass the examination are issued INDIAN CDC and are eligible for ship jobs around the world. The students can join ship as trainee OS (Ordinary Seaman) / trainee fitter / trainee oiler / trainee engine room cadet (for Diploma holders).

Important Instructions to Students

Please read the following carefully :

1. The standing rules and regulation of the Academy shall be binding on all students. This may be changed without prior intimation to the students.
2. Act of major indiscipline will be a cause for rustication from the Academy. Minor offences will be dealt with by the Principal CS / Warden and warning letter may be sent to parents if considered necessary with rustication for repeated offenders.
3. All candidates are to maintain the highest discipline and imbibe the spirit of comradeship during their period of training.
4. Candidate will not be allowed to keep gold ornaments or other valuable items or any kind of electrical appliances / gadgets. Money over Rs.50/- is to be deposited with the office and may be drawn as necessary.
5. Uniform is to be worn at all times during training. Hence, very few civilian clothes are to be brought. Uniforms will be supplied within one week of joining.
6. Candidates are permitted 'Shore Leave', in uniform only, on Sundays between 0900 and 2000 hrs. No shore leave however, will be allowed in the first month.
7. Candidates are not allowed to stay out of the campus at night under any circumstances. Parents are instructed not to make any request for the same.
8. The use of tobacco and alcohol is strictly prohibited in the Institute premises. Long hair, moustache and beards are not allowed during the period of training. Sikh candidates are exempt from this provision.
9. The fees once paid will not be refunded or transferred to any other candidate's account. If due to any reason the training is extended beyond 25 weeks, the candidate will have to pay extra charges as per the decision of Yak Education Trust.
10. The candidates will be wholly responsible for making any wrong declaration, or for the submission of false certificates, which will make them liable for prosecution and removal from the course.
11. The completed application form should reach the Trust head office on, or before, the prescribed Date.
12. The Trust will not be responsible for any delay in submissions or incomplete forms.
13. The selection of candidates will be on the basis of written examination and an Interview.
14. All communication will be in English.
15. The Trust reserves the right to select or reject any candidate. The decision of the Chairman will be final and no appeal of any type shall be entertained. A Selection Board of Professionals shall be appointed by the Trust to ensure proper selection.
16. Any suppression of truth, mis-representation of fact or submission of false certificates will result in Cancellation of admission, forfeiture of fees and shall be punishable as per the Law.
